

## **HOME STUDY REQUIREMENT CHECKLIST**

## **DOCUMENTS NEEDED**

Your home study provider will have a specific list of required items that they will need. Here is a general list, typical of most home study requirements. Use this in preparation as you evaluate your home study readiness and plan time to request documents you may need to order.

$\bigcirc$	Completed Home Study Questionnaire (from your provider)
$\bigcirc$	Autobiographical Statement
$\bigcirc$	Birth Certificates (certified copy for everyone living in your home)
$\bigcirc$	Marriage Certificate (typically certified copy required)
$\bigcirc$	Divorce Decrees (typically certified copy required)
$\bigcirc$	Proof of Insurance (Medical, Auto, Home, Life)
$\bigcirc$	Military Discharge Information
$\bigcirc$	Passports (if adopting internationally)
$\bigcirc$	Tax Returns
$\bigcirc$	Financial information
$\bigcirc$	Verification of Employment
$\bigcirc$	Health History Forms (from provider)
$\bigcirc$	Physician Examination Statement (not more than 6 months old)
$\bigcirc$	HIV Test Results
$\bigcirc$	TB Test Results
$\bigcirc$	Criminal Record Statement
$\bigcirc$	Proof of Live Scan Fingerprinting
$\bigcirc$	Child Abuse Database Clearance
$\bigcirc$	Sex Offender Database Clearance
$\bigcirc$	DMV Forms
$\bigcirc$	School Report for any Minor Children in the Home
$\bigcirc$	Letters of Recommendation (Usually no more than 6 required)
$\bigcirc$	Pet Vaccination records
$\bigcirc$	Adoption Decrees (for any other adopted children)

## **PREPARING YOURSELF**

Your home study provider will have specific requirements for education that is part of the adoption preparation process. Typically the following are required:

- O CPR and First Aid Training
- O Parenting Classes (that include parenting adopted children)
- Transracial Adoptive Parenting (if open to adopting outside of your race)
- O Parenting the Older Child (if open to adopting older children)
